getcryptocoin - Software Licence & Operator Responsibility

This document is not legal advice. It states the basis on which the software is provided.

1. What this is

This is a software product. getcryptocoin (the developer) licenses you a copy of source code and configuration that you compile, deploy and run ****on your own infrastructure****. It is the same kind of thing as any other open or commercial codebase: you receive software, not a service, a coin, a security, or an investment.

The reference chain ships configured for a testnet. Testnet coins have ****no monetary value and are not for sale**. The software makes no representation****** that any coin you create will have, hold, or gain value.

2. You become the operator

When you deploy this software you become the operator of whatever you run, and - if you choose to launch a network whose coins are assigned value - the issuer. From that point:

- You run the nodes, pool, explorer, faucet and any services. They run on your servers, under your control.
- You decide whether to stay on testnet or launch a mainnet with value. That decision, and everything that follows from it, is yours alone.

3. Your responsibilities

You are solely responsible for, as applicable to you and your jurisdiction(s):

- Licensing, registration and regulatory compliance (e.g. UK FSMA / FCA, EU MiCA, US federal and state law, and any equivalent elsewhere).
- Financial-promotion rules for anything you say or publish about a coin.
- AML / KYC / sanctions / counter-terrorist-financing obligations.
- Tax, accounting and reporting.
- Data protection for any users you onboard.
- Custody and security of any keys, funds or user data you hold.

If you are not certain whether an activity is regulated where you operate, take your own professional legal advice before you do it.

4. What the developer does NOT do

getcryptocoin (Steven Tobin), as the developer/licensor:

- Operates nothing on your behalf and has no operational connection to any network you run.
- Holds no keys, no coins, no funds, and provides no custody for you or your users.
- Is not your partner, agent, issuer, exchange, broker, or financial-services provider.
- Makes no promise about value, returns, profit, liquidity, or the success of anything you launch.

5. Acceptable use

You may not use this software to commit fraud, operate a pyramid/Ponzi or pump-and-dump scheme, launder money, evade sanctions, or do anything unlawful in any jurisdiction that applies to you. The licence terminates automatically if you do.

6. LICENCE VALIDATION AND TERMINATION - READ THIS SECTION

This software contains a licence check. Paid bundles ship with a `license.env` file (your order ID + licence key) and a `check-license.sh` script that contacts `getcrypto.co.in/api/license/check` to confirm the licence is still valid. Free evaluation bundles have no key and no enforcement.

The only events that terminate a licence are: (a) a refund of your purchase, (b) a chargeback / payment reversal, or (c) a breach of this licence (section 5). Nothing else does, and termination is never discretionary.

What happens on termination - exactly:

1. You are notified by email, and the check script tells you on this server.
2. Nothing is disabled for a 14-day grace period from the first failed check.
3. After the grace period, the script stops the stack's services on your server. It does not delete or modify your data, chain state, wallets, keys or files - services stop; everything else is untouched.
4. If the dispute is resolved, the licence is re-enabled and `setup.sh` brings everything straight back.

Offline protection: if the licence server cannot be reached - for any reason - nothing is ever disabled. You have a 30-day offline tolerance, and an unreachable server is never treated as a termination. The check runs weekly; you can read every line of `check-license.sh` to verify all of this yourself.

By installing and using a paid bundle you agree to this licence-validation mechanism as a term of the licence.

7. No warranty, no liability

The software is provided "AS IS", without warranty of any kind. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the developer is not liable for any loss or damage arising from your use of, or inability to use, the software - including any loss connected to a network, coin, or service you operate.

Nothing in this software or its documentation is legal, financial, tax or investment advice.
